

## Language Building: Active & Passive Verbs

- Let's confirm what we just watched:

When the verb is **active**, the subject of the sentence did something to something.

(subject) (verb) (object)

e.g. The man read a leaflet.

We are now turning the verb into the passive:

(object) (verb) (subject)

e.g. A leaflet was read by the man.
